

Dr. Chris Richardson is an expert in the physics of emission line regions, particularly those surrounding active black holes. He graduated from Eastern Illinois University magna cum laude with degrees in physics and applied physics. He attended Michigan State University for his doctoral work, where he earned a PhD in astrophysics. Dr. Richardson has been a faculty member at Elon University since 2013. He was a visitor at the COSMS Institute for the 2020-2021 academic year and is currently an Associate Professor of Astrophysics at Elon University, where he holds the Japepth E. Rawls endowed professorship.
